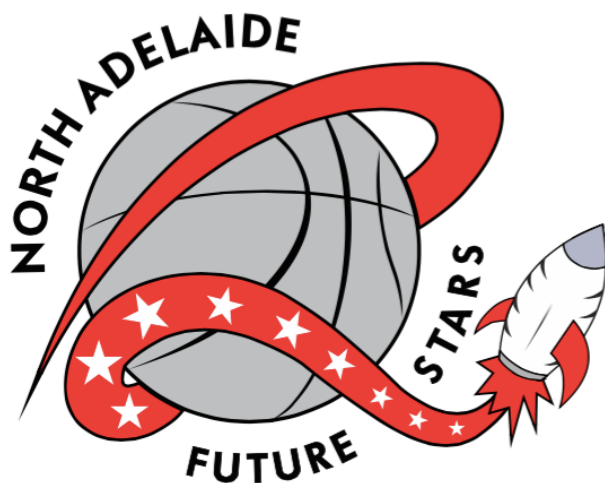

## **Future Stars Basketball League (FSL)**

The Future Stars Basketball League (FSL) is a local Domestic Competition run by the North Adelaide Basketball Club (NABC) for families who are looking for an organised, localised and affordable basketball competition. The FSL competition gives players a stepping stone towards the District program.

The Domestic competition is open to all junior players both girls and boys (U8s to U18s) of all abilities.

## **What are the Domestic seasons?**

Basketball runs over two 'seasons', which encompasses two school terms per season.

The 1<sup>st</sup> season of 2022, started February 12.

## **When are Domestic games played?**

All Domestic games are played on Saturday's game times varying depending on the age group played.

## **Where are Domestic games played?**

Game day locations are:

- The Lights Community & Sports Ctr - 244 East Parkway Corner Hampstead Road and, East Pkwy, Lightsview SA 5085
- Modbury High School – 62 Pompoota Road Modbury SA 5092
- Torrens Valley Christian School – 1227 Grand Junction Road Hope Valley SA 5090

## **Who do Domestic teams play against?**

The Domestic competition is made up of teams put together by the club as a pathway program to district these clubs are Northern, Hampstead, Lightsview, Parkway, Paradise, Enfield & Windsor.

We also host a number of school and community groups who participate over varying age groups.

### **How much does it cost?**

- Player Registration \$10 per season
- Basketball SA Affiliation fee \$26.05 paid Annually – cover all affiliation fees and insurance  
The above is paid via an online link emailed with team placement information.
- Game fees are paid per term

### **Spectators are FREE**

### **How often do Domestic teams train?**

In 2022, we have changed our training program to the 'Futures Academy'

The 'Futures Academy' will involve weekly sessions where development of individual skills & team concepts will be the top priority.

Players will be training with other kids of their own age & gender.

There will be small groups – 9 players per basket, 1 coach per basket – so players are getting more focused and personal attention than ever before.

In addition, the content taught at the Futures Academy will mirror what is taught at the Rockets Academy, enabling a smoother transition when players move to an NABC District team.

The cost for these sessions can vary term to term, with information sent via email

## What is the Domestic uniform and how much does it cost?

- Domestic team uniform including reversible playing singlet and shorts \$70 per set.
- Please Note: Uniforms to be worn with your club name on the outside, unless a clash, in which case the 2<sup>nd</sup> listed team wears the reverse side. See below example:

- Uniforms are available for purchase through our uniform shop in the office at The Lights, which is open Saturdays 9-4 (pending staff availability)

### **How do I get a playing number?**

Once the player has registered and received confirmation that they have been placed in a team, we will arrange a uniform and domestic player numbers are issued by the administration upon ordering.

NOTE: Player numbers DO NOT transfer between Domestic & District. If you are a Domestic player going into the District competition you must obtain a District player number. Occasionally, we may be able to issue you with the same number, however it is not guaranteed.

NOTE: If you intend on purchasing a second-hand uniform you must first check with the above listed to determine whether or not the player number is available. If it is available, your number will be registered on our system. If you obtain a second hand top and do not register the number, you will be expected to change numbers (buy a new top) in the event of a clash with an existing player or any future player.

### **Loan Singlet Process**

To ensure that players have a singlet to play in while waiting for their new singlet to be delivered, FSL have established a set of loan singlets. When you place and pay for a new reversible playing singlet in our online store, you will be issued with a loan top (stock permitting). You are required to take back the loan singlet (in good, clean condition) at the time of picking up your order. Your order will not be released until the loan top is returned.

## FSL FEE'S

- Club membership fees will need to be paid upon registration and cover the player for that season.
- Basketball SA Affiliation fees will need to be paid upon registration and cover the player for the following 12 months
- Uniforms will also need to be paid in full for your uniform to be received.

## **Volunteering & Involvement**

Future Stars League operates as a not-for-profit organisation which relies heavily on the generosity of volunteers to be able to deliver a full range of basketball activities.

Get involved in a great family environment while helping to deliver the sport of basketball to our local community.

We are always looking for more people to help out no matter how much they are able to contribute.

Being a part of the Future Stars family, we actively encourage all our members to volunteer to help the Club in some way. Roles you can assist with:

**Coaches** – the Club is always keen to acquire new coaches. If you have any prior experience or are interested in coaching please let the Club know.

All coaches are required to fulfil Basketball SA's Coach Registration requirements including a police check/WWCC.

**Team Managers** – each team has a nominated team manager who should be approached as your first point of contact. Their role is to manage the team and to liaise with parents, players and the coach.

**Scoring** – each player is expected to provide a scorer (usually a parent/guardian) who will be rostered to score via the team manager. On average, when spread fairly between a team, you can score as little as 3 times each season.

## **Player Registration**

In order for players to be covered by insurance they will need to be registered online – using their correct details including an email address so that in the case where an incident is reported Basketball SA can ensure the correct information is being used on the player's behalf.

To register all you need to do is click on the link provided when we send your placement email and enter the team code –you will then be prompted through two screens that will collect your details.

By doing this they will then be covered by the competition's accident insurance – in the case that a player is added part way through the season just contact myself and we can get them registered (this will need to be done before their first game in the competition).

Please ensure all of your players are registered ASAP it is a requirement of the competition that players/families register themselves online with correct details in order to play for player safety.

When prompted to put in your team # please enter your uniform number – if you do not have a uniform please enter 99 as your team #.
