PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2022 - 2023

Back to normal? In many respects our 2022/23 season might have reflected normality but there were also quite a few changes. Having endured truncated seasons in the previous two years it was back to a full season involving two-day cricket again and 21 weeks of competition.

We initiated a name change from West Gippsland to Casey Cardinia to reflect our local government areas and this meant quite a bit of rebranding for livery, trophies, and social media. Our parent bodies are still adjusting to the change.

While we reintroduced a full season, the format was also adjusted with all clubs fitting into either Premier cricket or District grades. The structure seemed to work satisfactorily and will continue in the forthcoming season after which a re-evaluation might be necessary. However, clubs will be consulted. A comprehensive survey provided us with ticks for many of our processes and highlighted the need to evaluate others. Surveys have been carried out at Senior and Junior level to assist with preparation and organization to improve our communication processes. We tried out a split innings format in F Grade and it received a tick from the majority of clubs. Other formats might be considered to ensure that cricketers play the type of cricket they enjoy.

Jack Anning and the Senior Cricket Committee revamped the Kookaburra Cup into two divisions and the competition proved to be a great success with Cranbourne Meadows and Cardinia earning the title of Premiers. The finals were held at Pakenham and were very well organized. Thanks to all those who worked hard to make it a success.

Our Juniors returned to the VMCU Carnival in January and enjoyed representative cricket again. The CCCA is looking for a group to share the organization for the carnival and would love to hear from people who are happy to assist. Hopefully organization can begin well before our season begins. That is a segway for raising one of the abiding limitations to our cricket. We need volunteers in a lot of areas. While representative cricket will benefit, having more clubs share responsibility for organizing our cricket will

make the CCCA a stronger organization.

Many people require thanking for their efforts over the last season. Shane Dalton's work as Secretary is invaluable and constant. Nicky Simpson's hours of work on fixture matters were highly appreciated by everyone. The attention to detail from Narelle Stow as MyCricket manager often goes un-noticed. But with the transition to Play HQ she is at the forefront and leading us all to the new platform. All clubs need to ensure they are completely educated about the new system to ensure your club is well organized.

Thanks also go to other Board members – Aaron Straughair for his work as Treasurer and Trevor Martin as Umpire Chief. Trevor worked hard to train his band well in the job of managing the application of the rules. We still need more umpires though. If you would like to be involved in the game, contact Trevor to offer your services.

Two committees shared responsibility for managing our cricket. The Senior Cricket Committee, consisting of Jamie Smith, Ben Parrot, Bradey Welsh and Ben Knowles were well led by Jack Anning helping oversee senior cricket. Similarly, the Junior Management Committee of Nicky Simpson, Steve Sawrey and Scott Webster constantly gathered to ensure junior cricket was run as smoothly as possible.

Our Association was supported well by our sponsors – Kookaburra our major sponsor, Grilld a new sponsor this season, Bendigo Bank Kooweerup and Lang Lang Branch, who supported Girls' Cricket and Star News Group who provide an excellent platform to promote our competition. Thanks Dave Nagle, our enthusiastic Sports Editor at the Gazette for your expert coverage of our passion. We also received constant support and advice from our Area Managers Chris Harris and Peter Symons from Cricket Victoria. A special tribute also needs to be paid to Megan Pauwels who passionately supported us until recent times. Congratulations to all the Premiers in all grades - led by Kooweerup at the top. Enjoy your cricket.
