## FOOTBALL REVIEW

Reigning-champion Tooradin-Dalmore is on the board.

It's been 25 long years since that line was trotted out after the Seagulls overcame a brave early challenge from Cora Lynn to record a 40-point victory in the WGFNC season opener at the Tooradin Rec Reserve on Saturday.

Minus a host of key premiership drought-breakers from September 10 last year, the Gulls looked in serious trouble early in the third quarter before producing a brilliant 20 minutes of football to take control of the contest.

The Gulls kicked 11 goals to two in the second half to waltz away with a 14.8.92 to 7.10.52 victory in front of a bumper home crowd.

The Gulls unleashed two gun recruits, with Hayden Bertoli-Simmonds slotting nicely into the midfield and key defender Ray Lengyel taking on the enormous task of quelling the league leading goal-kicker in Nathan Gardiner.

The Cobras also had reason to be excited, with club royalty in Nathan and Ryan Gillis returning to familiar surroundings after stints with Somerville in the MPNFL.

The early exchanges were typical of a season opener.

Both teams crashed in hard, with Seagulls midfielder Liam Adams laying the foundations for a best-on-ground performance with the first goal for the season, after just two minutes of play.

But the Cobras refused to buckle.

The visitors kicked the remaining four majors of the first quarter, with Cory Machaya – who started brilliantly in the midfield – starting the surge with a set shot from 40 after 13 minutes of play.

The Gillis boys then turned on the magic.

Ryan soccered one through heavy traffic, on his left foot, at the 18-minute mark, before Nathan kicked a cracker on the run from the resultant centre clearance to have the Cobras up and about.

And when Gardiner converted a fortunate marking decision from the boundary, the Cobras were 18 points up at quarter time.

Gardiner had two late chances - snaps of either foot - to increase the margin just prior to the first break.

Tooradin-Dalmore coach Lachie Gillespie wasn't too disheartened, despite the Gulls conceding four goals in 10 minutes of play.

"I wasn't too disappointed, it was competitive and the boys played pretty well early, then they stepped up and got a few goals in a row which we don't like to concede," Gillespie said.

"They played well early and used the footy well, but there was no panic from our point of view, it was really good footy to be honest.

"We found our feet in the second quarter and got things back on our terms and then played some really good footy in the third quarter."

That might be the early-season contender for 'understatement of the year'...because the Seagulls were brilliant in the third term.

Trailing by 11 points at the major interval, the Gulls conceded the first goal of the second half – in the opening minute of play – before putting their stamp on proceedings.

And the fuse was lit by none other than Piva Wright – the best-on-ground medallist from last year's grand final!

Wright kicked an absolute bomb, off one step, from 55 out, at the five minute mark to spark the Seagulls into action.

With the midfield now on top, Julian Suarez then converted from a free kick before Stewie Scanlon finished beautifully after silver-service from Adams.

There were danger signs for the Cobras when Wright kicked his second for the quarter, bending through a set shot from the cricket nets forward pocket.

Scanlon then converted another, and when Adams ran into an open goal at the 25-minute mark the Seagulls were up and away.

They led by 19 points at the final change before booting five goals to one in the final term.

Gillespie was delighted, not just with the win but with the way his team performed with so many new faces on board.

Quality such as skipper Jordy Kelly (calf), Brent Macaffer (wedding) and Matt Livermore (farming) were all sidelined on the weekend, but some fresh stock was right up to the task.

"We had a couple in from outside, but most of it from there is just internal," Gillespie said.

"Tom Bethune came up and played his fourth senior game, we had Charlie Shinnars play his first senior game, Jehi Esler from the under 18s played his fifth game...there were five players that had no more than seven senior games of experience.

"It was awesome; it was really cool to have eight new faces from the grand final side.

"We feel like we've got that core nucleus, we always talk about structure and Tooradin footy and how that's more important than the individuals, but it's just nice to have it tested with a few quality players on the sidelines."

Gillespie praised Wright for his intimidating impact in the third term, but was more content with the overall team performance.

"Piva (Wright) did some pretty strong physical work and kicked a couple of goals, he lifted, but the midfield group lifted as well," he said.

"They were far too good and quick for us in the first quarter, and even periods of the second, but our midfield settled down a little bit and stopped getting ahead of the footy.

"The group played well, but when Piva turns it on it's pretty hard to stop."

Gillespie said Cora Lynn is going to cause opposition clubs some major headaches this year.

"They're really well organised, they've definitely made a few changes to their game-plan from last year, they would have had a lot more disposals than last time we played them," he said.

"They got moving pretty quickly, they linked up really well by hand and they've got a very serious forward line.

"They're going to be a very dangerous side this season and will only get better as the year rolls on."

Adams, Bertoli-Simmonds and veteran defender Adam Galea were amongst the best for the Seagulls, while Suarez finished with three, leading a band of multiple goal-kickers.

Adams, Bertoli-Simmonds, Scanlon, Wright and Blake Grewar all jagged a couple each for the champs.

Gardiner was the only multiple goal-kicker for the Cobras, ending the day with three, while newcomers Luke Black and Matt Briggs joined regular stars such as Lachie Peluso, Luke Ryan, Tristan Warkuss and Machaya on the best-players list.

Cora Lynn next host Garfield on Saturday 15 April, while the Seagulls also return home on the same day to take on Kilcunda-Bass.

# FOOTBALL REVIEW

Four teams that played finals football in 2022 are set to lock horns in a bumper round-one Easter Saturday edition of the West Gippsland Football Netball Competition (WGFNC).

Last year's defeated grand finalists, Phillip Island, roll out the welcome mat for Warragul Industrials, in the first clash between the clubs since their epic preliminary final from last year.

Scores were tied at the final siren, and after two periods of extra time, before the Bulldogs squeezed through to the big dance in the most dramatic style possible.

It ended a dream finals campaign for the Dusties, who finished sixth before conquering Inverloch-Kongwak (Elimination) and Cora Lynn (Semi) to make it through to the penultimate game of the season.

Harmit Singh once again takes the reins at the Dusties, while the pre-eminent player in the WGFNC of the last five years – Cam Pederson – takes over the plum job at Phillip Island from master-coach Beau Vernon.

Will the Dusties stand up once again, or will the Bulldogs take the first step towards regaining their crown?

The other match up on Saturday takes place at the Inverloch Recreation Reserve where the Sea Eagles will welcome Nar Nar Goon to their fortress.

These two teams were the real disappointments of the 2022 finals series – both going in as elimination final favourites but being bundled out in week one.

The Sea Eagles were the first victim of an inspired Dusties line-up, while the Goons' big guns failed to deliver against Cora Lynn.

It sets up an intriguing first game for the season for both clubs.

After a turbulent 2022, the Goon will head into this week's clash after a solid pre-season under new coach Justin Stanton.

"Pre-season has been good, we've had three practice matches against Drouin, Traralgon and Warragul and it gave me the chance to have a look at the entire squad, by rotating through the three practice matches," Stanton said.

"We got a couple of injuries out of it, but overall our list is in pretty good shape and we're looking forward to the weekend and putting out a very competitive team."

The Goons home ground at Spencer Street has been resurfaced over the Spring and Summer months, meaning Stanton and his team have had James Bathe Reserve in Pakenham as their training base.

Stanton has been impressed by the commitment of his players, and the club as a whole.

"The turnout at training has been a real positive, considering the fact that we've been training off site for the pre-season," he said.

"It's been great that the guys have still been showing up and putting the hard work in, and it's been great to have good support from the Nar Nar Goon faithful during the practice matches as well.

"As for the playing personnel, what's impressed me has been their keenness and enthusiasm to learn the way we want them to

play, that's been encouraging.

"As for the list itself, it's a young list, but with that comes the opportunity to have a coachable group that's keen to learn and wants to get better.

"These boys are envious of watching clubs like Tooradin and Phillip Island in recent years and they want to put themselves in the positions that those clubs have been in over the last few years."

Stanton said the WGFNC football public can expect to see an exciting brand of football from the Goon in 2023.

"We want to play an attractive brand of football, because we think that's going to give us the best chance to compete with those bigger clubs," he said.

"We want to be a team that attacks the scoreboard heavily and if that means we leak some goals on the back of us being ultra-aggressive forward of the football, then so be it.

"We'll try and move the footy quick.

"I told guys from night one of pre-season that whatever flair you've got to your game...I want you bringing that every week.

"If you like to run, take a few bounces and take the game on, then do that...we don't want to be robotic and we've got a game style that I think will really complement our skillset."

Stanton said he can't wait to coach his first game for the club against high-quality opposition.

"I'm really excited by the opportunity to play Inverloch, who have been a terrific club for a long time, a great set-up down there, and Nar Nar Goon has never beaten Inverloch at Inverloch...so that's an exciting challenge to take on for us," he said.

"I'm looking forward to it, and looking forward to that all-inclusive atmosphere that comes with having so many football and netball clubs aligned throughout the day.

"I can't wait."

# NETBALL REVIEW

Tooradin-Dalmore is more than happy to be the first team to enjoy the sweet taste of success in West Gippsland netball in 2023...and it hopes to be the last!

After its absence from grand final day last year – and two previous seasons ruined by COVID – the Seagulls are eyeing off a return to the biggest day on the calendar where they last enjoyed success in 2019.

Head Coach Kelly Haynes and her support staff have been busy preparing the Gulls for a huge challenge this year, and the perennial finalists are on track after a season-opening 57-34 victory over Cora Lynn on Saturday.

The Seagulls have a fresh look this season, with star goaler Alex Duff moving to Darwin, being replaced by Haynes herself, while emerging mid-courter Abbey Howes is already making an impact after rising from the 17-unders.

"It's just great to have a lot of our girls back again in 2023," Haynes said.

"I know some clubs have struggled, post-Covid, getting teams together, but we're just so lucky to have such a loyal player base.

"And seeing four of our 17s come up to senior grades has been great for the club as well.

"And to have Jess Cox back, who played in the three grand finals that we won, that tops things off nicely."

Haynes said the Seagulls were in great nick after enduring some extra work during the pre-season.

"We took on the feedback from the girls that they wanted a longer pre-season, so we actually came back a bit earlier and did some targeted training on our footwork and fitness, before breaking off into our teams," she said.

"We get great numbers to our training sessions and we've been really happy to see what they've produced in the pre-season.

"I think not making it last year has put some fire in the belly and we're looking forward to challenging the better teams in the competition."

The Seagulls started steadily against the Cobras on Saturday, leading 14-9 at the first break, before producing their best netball in the second quarter.

Ebony Mason (GK) and Jess Maher (GD) kept things typically tight in defence, while Zoe Coventry (WD) and Sara Howie (C) linked up well through the midcourt.

But it was the quarter-time inclusion of Howes that made all the difference according to Haynes.

"We had a few wrinkles to iron out in the first quarter, even the connection between myself and Alex (Maher – GS)

wasn't great," Haynes explained.

"It was great to have everyone contributing and everyone discussing things at quarter time about what we could do better.

"But the difference in the second quarter was Abbey Howes coming on for her first game as a true A Grader.

"She just dominated and opened up the space and gave A-Ma (Alex Maher) that one-on-one contest in the circle."

The Cobras, missing key play-maker Bianca Douglas, battled hard after half time, particularly in the final term, but the damage had been done with that 19-10 second term.

Maggie Blackman (GK) and Danielle Cameron (GD) combined well at the defensive end of the court for the Cobras, while Karla Brook (C), Miller Willis (WA) and Moesha Griffin (WD) worked hard through the middle third.

But the Seagulls produced a very encouraging performance to already set the bar high.

"We came in, in our first year (2019), and took out A, B and C, but that pushed the other clubs to really kick it up a gear as well, and there's real competitiveness in each game," Haynes said.

"Even on the weekend, the game might look easy on the scoresheet, but there are no easy games and you know you're always going to get a competitive game.

"There's always a defender on your tail and we love being in this league.

"It's really great-quality netball, from seniors all the way through to juniors."
