

ROUND 6 FOOTBALL PREVIEW

The top-two teams – Inverloch-Kongwak and Dalyston – will meet in the West Gippsland Football Netball Competition (WGFNC) Match of the Day on Saturday.

It's been six long years since those words were muttered as the former Alberton League rivals prepare for a massive showdown at Dalyston in the highlight clash of round six.

The Magpies and Sea Eagles did it twice in 2017 - the inaugural year of the WGFNC - beginning round six in first and second place and fighting out a thrilling draw.

They then maintained those positions until round 15, when the Sea Eagles prevailed by 28 points on the same deck that this week's game will be played.

One v two . . . the Magpies and Sea Eagles owned that domain just six-short years ago!

The Magpies were the trend-setters that year, with Brad Fisher and Michael Kraska in dominant form . . . until that round 15 loss to Invertoch

That loss triggered a staggering fall from grace, with the Magpies losing three of their last four games and being bundled out in straight sets.

Inverloch-Kongwak would go on to win the flag!

Only four players fronted up for all 20 games that year, with Clay Tait and Kyle Kirk joined by two familiar names to the 2023 flock of Magpies . . . Dean Wylie and Michael Marotta.

Wylie, the former half-bank flanker, is now senior coach, while Marotta is still an influential figure through the midfield.

Only six players from that 2017 list - numbering 34 - have played senior football this year, with Marotta joined by Blake Carew, Jack Legione, Joe Alexander, Kurt Thomas and Michael Harris on that exclusive loyalty-list.

And haven't those six seen some pain since the glory days of 2017!

Until this year, the Magpies had won just seven of 58 games since 2017 and became one of the whipping boys of the competition.

But that's enough of the history lesson . . . you get the picture . . . let's turn the clock forward to now!

The Magpies enter this week's showdown with a four-game winning streak, their best since the Sea Eagles ended a sixgame run in . . . sorry . . . that round 15, 2017 clash.

The inclusion of players like Mitch Hallahan and Brayden Duve has strengthened up the midfield, giving Marotta and Curtis Murfett some much-needed support, while Brayden Bowes and key defender Will Clarke have toughened things up in the key posts.

For the first time in six years, the Magpies look like a footy team again!

But this is their biggest test, the biggest team for any team in the WGFNC this year.

A four-game streak against Kilcunda-Bass, Korumburra-Bena,

Bunyip and Cora Lynn is one thing, but challenging the Sea Eagles this week would bring some true credibility to the rebuild.

It's no secret, Tom Hams has the Sea Eagles flying at the moment.

Hams is one of 16 players that have played all five games this season, with key inclusions such as Tate Short, Nick Baltas, Will Hams, Liam O'Neill and Kairon Dorling also on the list.

Lewis Rankin continues to patrol the back half, while Toby Mahoney has been in great form in front of the big sticks.

They really do look the ultimate all-round package this season.

The Magpies won't win this one, and will probably lose handsomely, but fighting things out for four quarters - against the current premiership favourites – will certainly add to the credibility that Wylle and his team so crave.

In the other feature game this week, Cora Lynn and Nar Nar Goon both disappointed badly last start and will look to rebound quickly at the Goon on Saturday.

The Goon midfield – minus skipper Trent Armour – looked like a ship without a rudder against Tooradin-Dalmore last week, with the Seagulls winning clearance after clearance for fun.

The Goon will be missing Armour for a lengthy duration, and need players to step up.

They conceded six goals in a 10-minute period in the second term last week . . . all generated from the midfield!

The next fortnight is crucial for the Goon, with games against the Cobras and Warragul Industrials probably 50-50 battles considering where the Goon is at right now.

This is the ultimate toss-of-the-coin job . . . but it's the Goon to rebound and win narrowly.

In other games this week, Phillip Island and Tooradin-Dalmore will have percentage-boosting wins over Bunyip and Korumburra-Bena respectively, while a coughing and spluttering Warragul Industrials machine should be too good for Kooweerup at home.

And Kilcunda-Bass and Garfield will fight out an intriguing battle at the Bass Recreation Reserve.

This appears to be a battle between two teams that will sit side-by-side on the ladder at seasons end, so it's a must-win for both clubs.

Expect the Panthers midfield, and talent up forward, to sneak them home by under 20 points.

ROUND 5 NETBALL REVIEW

This is what it's all about!

The top four premiership contenders in West Gippsland netball will lock horns this week as the undefeated records of Inverloch-Kongwak, Dalyston and Tooradin-Dalmore go on the line.

Reigning premier Inverloch heads to Dalyston for its biggest challenge of the season in a massive one-two clash that promises to be a beauty.

At the same time, 30 minutes away at Korumburra, the Giants host Tooradin-Dalmore as they look to join the Seagulls on five wins for the season.

It's going to be a magnificent afternoon of netball – and one we can't wait to see unfold.

All four teams were mightily impressive on the weekend...and let's start at the top.

Inverloch-Kongwak is the only team to score 50 goals in every game this season after a thumping 93–17 victory over Warraqul Industrials.

With one eye firmly fixed on this week's encounter with the Magpies, the Sea Eagles showed no mercy in a dominant four-quarter display.

Coach Jarrad Walker got the balance of his three-pronged goaler attack just right, with Amy Scott (32 goals), Ella Sadler (31) and Kelly Boyd (30) all taking turns in the spotlight.

It's a spotlight that will really heat up against the Magpies this week and players like Lanni Pryor (WA), Linsey Boddy (GK) and Renee Pilkington (GD) appear ready and set for the challenge.

The Dusties would have been in even more trouble if not for the efforts of Rachel Francis and Sam Beaton through the midcourt.

Dalyston was less impressive, but still got the Mother's Day weekend chocolates, with a 46–26 win over Cora Lynn.

The Cobras came to play with real defensive intent and only allowed the Magpies to score eight goals in the first quarter, but managed just five goals themselves.

With Hannah McRae (C) in great form through the midcourt the Magpies gradually pulled away, particularly in the third term with a 17–7 onslaught.

Maggie Blackman and Danielle Cameron defended with everything they had for the Cobras, who remain one of two teams searching for their first win – alongside Warragul Industrials.

Tooradin-Dalmore continues to play an exciting brand of netball with the Seagulls making it five on the trot with a 54-41 victory over Nar Nar Goon.

The first quarter was a red-hot contest, with the Gulls leading 13–10, before Alex Maher (GS) and Kelly Haynes (GA) ramped things up in the second term.

Haynes played the perfect foil, providing Maher with some silver-service which allowed her to score 14 goals for the quarter.

The Gulls led 31–20 at half time, with the Goon dominating the early scoring in the third, before the Gulls settled to regain control of the contest.

Sara Howie (C) was crucial for the Gulls through the midcourt, while Chloe Crouch and Abbey Howes kept things lively for the winners.

The Goon stuck at it well, with skipper Chantelle Dale (C) providing great leadership after an early injury to Meaghan Winter left the home side a little short through the centre.

Kilcunda-Bass is celebrating its first win in the WGFNC A Grade competittion after a 51–42 triumph over Bunyip.

The Panthers have been competitive, but just falling short in recent times but made no such mistakes this time around.

Bunyip, with Jasmin Mackie (GS) on fire, skipped out to a 16–10 lead at quarter time before the Panthers fought back with a brilliant 15–6 second term

With Tam De Nardis (GA) in great form in the third, the Panthers extended their three-goal half-time lead to a match-winning nine-goal s at the final change before cruising home for victory.

Caitlin Egan (GK) and Caitlin Stephens (GD) were the real heroes for the Panthers, limiting Mackie to just 19 goals after quarter time.

Kooweerup is emerging as a real smoky to play finals after a come-from-behind 43–38 victory over Phillip Island.

The Bulldogs led by three at quarter time, and two at the half, before Kate Sidebottom's Demons kicked into gear in the third period of play.

The Demons scored 14–10 in the third, taking a two-goal lead to the final break, before winning 13–11 in the last.

The Demons have now won three in a row and face a winnable trip to Warragul this week.

Sidebottom was dynamic for her Demons, while Chantelle Stokkel (WD) also played a crucial role in the victory.

The Bulldogs have now lost their last four after a first-up win over Dusties.

And Korumburra-Bena will take confidence into a tough fortnight ahead after a 58–37 win over Garfield.

The Giants won every quarter by at least four goals, with Ash Cuff (C), Chelsea Fox (WD) and Gemma Dixon (GD) all key components in the victory.

The Giants now face a huge test; hosting Tooradin this week before paying a visit to Inverloch.
