Lots happening in our little patch too. Preseason for the whole club is now well underway. The Women's & Men's teams have been training since early August, and the Juniors kicked off on Sunday 20th August. Great to see some good numbers in the initial sessions and hopefully we will see numbers grow progressively as we get closer to the start of the season. Now just over a month or so away so time to start working on your game everyone!

Our women's and girl's programs continue to grow, and we are looking to get some new sponsors on board to support these blossoming programs. The proceeds from bar sales and our wonderful sponsors from last year, in conjunction with grants we have been able to obtain, are already funding a wonderful new Flicx pitch and a new point of sale system for the bar. The Flicx pitch is a portable cricket pitch we can roll out anywhere on our ovals and will be ideal for our women's social sixes and junior programs. The pitch comes already marked with 16, 18 and 20m pitch creases, and the truer bounce of the Flicx pitch will make learning batting skills much easier than learning them on natural grass. The new point of sale system we have purchased is Square, and will allow us lots of new functionality for our members and make life easier for our bar staff. It also provides a portal to easily see all our sales data and the app provides us with access to the system almost anywhere to take payments on a mobile phone or tablet.

Thank you for all your support so far. Still much more we would like to do to improve our offering to our Nuna CC community, so please continue to get behind our fundraising initiatives and let us know if you are able to assist in any way. Every little bit helps.

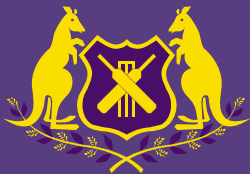

Training is well underway for the Women's Team and Stage 1 & Stage 2 girls teams with good numbers in attendance. We will be continuing the Social Sixes program on Monday evenings as a more social introduction to cricket for older girls and adults. We are also looking to make sure we have strong numbers of girls in our Cricket Blast Program with the objective of running an All Girls' Blast Program post Christmas to help transition these players into Stage 1 cricket in the following season. We'd love to recruit a few more players across all programs, so please get the word out amongst local (or not so local) friends and family.

It's been great to see the improvement in our women's players and to welcome back our junior girls players in more recent weeks.

There have been a great deal of firsts, with many of our senior team not having played competition cricket previously and some of our junior girls moving up from Stage 1 to Stage 2 cricket this season. In some cases this has been the first time wearing protective cricket gear, in others playing with a hard ball or bowling on a longer pitch. We are looking forward to celebrating many more firsts over the coming season as our players compete in their first hard ball cricket matches, take their first wickets, hit their first 4s or 6s, achieve personal best performances and have their first wins!
