COACH'S/FIRST XI REPORT

After being appointed captain coach the week after the Grand Final loss, it was a busy time in talking to players, officials and supporters to find out where individuals and the club was at. We were able to talk Tim Harper into the role of Team Manager. After interviewing the entire player list by phone or face to face, it was then important to establish our coaching panel for the upcoming season. We were fortunate to attract Dwayne Doig to the club as our first assistant which proved to be an important decision in the outcome of the season. Mal Coutts signed on as our second assistant and thirdly we were able to appoint Rob Prosser as a volunteer Assistant. Andy Johnson wanted to step up in a leadership role and was named our vice-captain for the season. After round 1 Tim stepped up as Chairman of Selectors for the firsts and seconds and Jack Heverin took on the role for the rest of the teams.

Preseason started in the first week of August with 26 people turning up on the night. The total numbers for preseason were 399 over 13 sessions that included 2 practice games. Early impressions were that people turned up to training but didn't necessarily know how to train with the intensity and organisation required to take the next step.

Round 1 saw us take on Pines in which we saw 14 year old Kieran Collins debut in the ones. We also saw the debut of Jarryd Amalfi and saw the future of the club with himself and Andy combining in a really good partnership.

20/20 season hit with a practise game against Cranbourne where we started to learn another form of the game and the way we need to play it. It was a good hit out with a squad that was a fair bit different to the home and away season team. We had to play P.O.B. in our first round and we acquitted ourselves without winning. However, we did learn a lot about the 20/20 game which will hold us in good stead for next season. The last 20/20 game of the season was against Pearcedale in the 'Bushman's Cup'. This proved to be an exciting game with a win off the last ball of the game.

Christmas came along and we were 6 and 0 but hadn't been challenged a whole lot and were still learning how to play team cricket. Training still needed to lift a gear with a further commitment from players to get to more training sessions. The team was still changing which was good to keep driving players for positions in the team. Everyone started to realise what structure we wanted for team balance and the reason why we had chosen those 4 goals to win a game of cricket.

We lost 2 out of the next 5 games leading into finals but it was still enough to finish on top of the ladder. The 2 losses were close games but were not necessarily beaten by those 11 players, but more by their main player's individual brilliance. We still had confidence in our game plan and team morale was the key to change our fortunes when confronted with difficult situations in a finals campaign.

Semi Final saw a match against Baden Powell in both our first and seconds, both at our home venue. Both our teams spent a lot of our warm-up time together and the camaraderie between both teams was fantastic. It was terrific to see as most of our seconds had played ones at some stage and were big reasons for us being in the Semi Final. Another great team batting display and some individual brilliance from Andy and Dwayne and we were in another Grand Final against Somerville.

Grand Final and the inclement weather was always going to test our team's patience. We only bowled 23 overs in some overcast conditions but through some good bowling and equally good fielding we had them 4 for 56. The next day and we needed some key wickets to stay ahead in the game. Enter Ben Johnson with 2 wickets in the second over of the day and we were clearly on top. Good catching and ground fielding and an inspired spell of bowling from Benny J and Somerville were all out for 113. We had a couple of hours to bat

as well as a lot of cricket the next week. The goal was partnerships to get us to the total. We passed them 3 down with David Ross on 56 not out when they pulled stumps. Celebrations followed and now the reality is here to start preparing for our re-emergence into Provincial cricket.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Gary and the committee for having faith in my ability and appointing me coach and for their continuing support throughout the season. A big thank you to Tim Harper for being our 12th player throughout the whole season and doing what you do for the team and club. Thanks to our Assistant Coaches for their hard work throughout the season. Thanks to Al for all his support as seconds captain, as well as all the other captains. To our support staff in Roger for scoring, Mick for his overall commitment to improving our players at training and game day and to Rob for being around the team when he could. Lastly I would like to thank all the players from all our grades for your commitment throughout the season, especially players that had the opportunity to play in the firsts this season.

Plenty of challenges lay ahead with our promotion as a club and further sacrifices will be asked of the playing group. We will need to play for each other more so than ever before to be competitive and to try and climb the ladder and position ourselves to be successful in Provincial cricket once again. Our playing list has a great mixture of experience and youth and we must keep on nurturing this youth to be better players for Langwarrin Cricket Club. Have a good off season and hope to everyone back for a very important season in the clubs history.
