SUBJECT: Lynbrook Football Club. Application to Affiliate with the DDJFL.

I hereby apply for affiliation to the DDJFL by the Lynbrook Football Club on behalf of the Lynbrook community. This letters details our efforts so far, systems in place, and to be put in place, for the club going forward to be well established and viable in 2010.

Background

1. Eight members of the Lynbrook community meet in early August, 2009 with a clear intention of establishing the Lynbrook Football Club.
2. Since that date an information/registration day has been held at the Lynbrook Shopping Centre, to determine local interest and support for a local football club.
3. A Code of Conduct has been established and Model Rules have been circulated to all working party members. We are waiting the statutory period before submitting the incorporation documents to Consumer Affairs Victoria.
4. We have met with Darryl Collings, AFLVIC, informed him of our intentions. We have received great support from Darryl with applications, direction and funding opportunities.
5. We have met with Casey Council who also has given us strong support.

Working Party

The eight member working party consists of the following;

- a. Andrew King - Lived in Lynbrook for 4 years, is associated with the Lynbrook Cricket Club and self employed with a number of businesses. Financial supporter.
- b. Tanya King - Lived in Lynbrook for 4 years. Local store owner and financial supporter.

- c. Terry Tisdale - Lived in Lynbrook for 6 years, works locally. Past President of the Clayton Junior Football Club and Vice President of the Clayton Senior Football Club.
- d. Yvonne Tisdale -Lived in Lynbrook for 6 years, works locally. Past Treasurer of the Clayton Junior Football Club.
- e. Ian Parker -Lived in Lynbrook for 6 years, Director of a local industrial company. Chairman of Selectors at Lynbrook Cricket Club. Financial supporter.
- f. Rick Misso -Lives locally. Owns own, local business. Played football at AFL level.
- g. Fiona Coles -Lives locally. Current Auskick Co-Ordinator for Lynbrook.
- h. Steve McPhail -Lives locally. President and founding member of the Lynbrook Cricket Club and Lynbrook Sports and Social Club.

Financial

Lynbrook Football Club has a zero monetary balance at this time. Funding will be applied for from Council, AFLVIC and VicHealth when Incorporation is complete.

Sponsorship has been sought and will be forthcoming from the following businesses in due course;

- Foiled Again Hairdressing.
- Nu Lite
- LJ Hooker Hampton Park
- First National Real Estate Lynbrook

Sponsorship is only in its early days until the club is fully established. At that point a Sponsorship Committee and a Fundraising Committee will be formed.

The Lynbrook Football Club Working Party is prepared to guarantee any funds that the league deems necessary.

A new ground and a pavilion have recently been built at the Lynbrook school area alleviating the need for any ground or clubroom expenses.

Numbers

We had 54 children register at our initial registration day. We intend to run another one as the season draws nearer. Other numbers will be drawn from the following:

- Promotion of the football club during summer to the existing seven junior cricket teams
- Promotion to the 700 children in the Lynbrook Primary School
- Local Auskick and canvassing of children that have left over the past 2 years
- Promotion at the local Catholic Primary School when established
- Promotion in the Lyndhurst area as that area falls within our current catchment area.

We are firm believers that once the local team is set up it will draw more interest from the local community and be self generating.

Three Year Plan

In our first year, 2010, we anticipate having two teams. Based on numbers from the registration day either Under 9 or 10 and under 12 seem likely teams at this point.

We expect to double our teams in the first three years. With the number of Prep grades at the primary school expanding we expect that the two existing teams will advance and will maintain teams in Under 9 and Under 10.

With sponsorship, fundraising and grants for jumpers and other start up equipment we expect to have a positive balance of a minimum of \$5000 in 2013.

Facilities

A new ground and clubroom/canteen facility has been built next to the Lynbrook Primary School.

The existing ground, Paterson Oval, is our second ground available with funding approved by council for a pavilion to be built in the near future.

Council has identified deficiencies in some equipment e.g. goal posts, etc which will be in place for the start of the season.

Operational/Volunteer Program

Some coaches have been identified as moving up through the ranks from Auskick and with Rick Misso's direction coaching programs will be in place.

Yvonne Tisdale has done the Trainers Course and will co-ordinate sourcing and training of trainers. Will also co-ordinate Canteen staff and Food Handlers Course for those in the canteen.

Ian Parker will co-ordinate Team Managers and Sponsorship.

WWC check applications will be on hand at the Club for Committee and other persons having contact with the children to fill out.

Licences

Liquor Licence is already in place with the Lynbrook Sports and Social Club, amendments will be made to times in due course.

Canteen will need to be registered with Council, as it was installed by Council no problems are expected.

We are very excited to be involved in this community project and hope that you will support us in our application.
